North Ranch Country Club

The new home of the Oak Park Spring Invitational is the beautiful North Ranch Country Club in Westlake Village, long-time home to USC's famed Southwestern Intercollegiate.

This championship golf course, designed by Ted Robinson and created in 1976, is renowned for its immaculate condition and challenging holes. Situated in the midst of countless oak trees are three uniquely separate nines: The Oaks and The Valley which will play host to the Varsity invitational; and The Lakes, which will serve as the course for the inaugural nine-hole JV competition.

From the 101 freeway take the Westlake Blvd. offramp. Go north approximately 2-1/4 miles to Valley Spring Drive. Turn right onto Valley Spring Drive. Go one mile to second stop sign. Turn left into North Ranch Country Club
